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**TEMA:** Simple Past. Irregular Verbs: affirmative form

### CUANDO UTILIZAMOS EL TIEMPO PASADO SIMPLE

El pasado simple se utiliza para hablar de **acciones que han sucedido anteriormente**, que pueden ser recientes o más lejanas en el tiempo.

Para formar el pasado simple, lo primero que tenemos que saber es si se trata de un verbo regular o irregular, pues su conjugación es muy diversa. Desafortunadamente, **no hay ninguna norma para formar los verbos irregulares**, por lo que hay que memorizarlos y aprenderlos con la práctica.

### ESTRUCTURA DE LA FRASE

Para formar el pasado simple de los verbos irregulares, basta con poner el sujeto, el verbo en pasado simple y los complementos necesarios. Por ejemplo:

*I **ate** chocolate yesterday.*

(Comí chocolate ayer).

### Irregular Verbs

<u>Presente</u>	<u>Pasado Simple</u>	<u>Pasado Participio</u>
Break (romper)	Broke	Broken
Run (correr)	Ran	Run
Feel (sentir)	Felt	Felt
Stand (ponerse de pie)	Stood	Stood

## Ejemplos en pasado simple:

- He broke the vase. / Él rompió el jarrón.
- She became a teacher in 1998. / Se convirtió en maestra en 1998.
- We ran for almost 2 hours. / Corrimos durante casi 2 horas.
- I understood all the lesson. / Entendí toda la lección.
- We felt so sad that day. / Nos sentimos muy tristes ese día.
