TEMA: Past Simple. Regular Verbs.

En esta ocasión trabajaremos con verbo **REGULARES** en el Pasado. Donde para formar su verbo en pasado solamente agregamos **"ED"** al mismo.

Mira los siguientes **EJEMPLOS**.

* He _____ (live) in China 15 years.

He **lived** in China 15 years. (El vivió en China 15 años)

* I _____ (cook) chicken last Friday.

I **cooked** chicken last Friday. (Yo cocine pollo el viernes pasado)

* We _____ (call) the police yesterday.

We **Called** the police yesterday. (Nosotros llamamos a la policía ayer)

-A la mayoría de los verbos solo "ed"	- Si finaliza el verbo en "E" solamente agregamos "D" al verbo	Doble Consonante , se duplica la última letra y coloca "ed"	"Consonante + Y , se quita la Y y se coloca "ied" al verbo	Vocal + Y , solamente se agrega "Ed" al verbo
-Walk- Walked -Talk – Talked -Answer- Answered	-Dance – Danced -Like- Liked -Arrive - Arrived	-Prefer – Preferred -Stop – Stopped -Travel - Travelled	-Study- Studied -Tidy – Tidied -Carry- Carried	-Play – Played -Enjoy – Enjoyed -Stay -Stayed
