Para conjugar los verbos en presente simple con los pronombre I,you, we,they los verbos no sufren ninguna modificación

Ejemplo I get up at 7:00. (yo me levanto a las 7:00)

Pero con las 3° personas del singular se debe conjugar agregando s, es, ies al verbo

LA TERCERA PERSONA DEL SINGULAR HE (ÉL) SHE (ELLA) IT (ESTO)

*Cuando un verbo termina en X,O,S,SS,SH,CH se agrega **ES** al verbo

Go: Ir He _____(go) to school. Aquí se pone GOES ya que habla de He(EI) y se modifica.

I _____(go) to school. Aquí solo GO

*Cuando tenemos el verbo HAVE(tener) se transforma en **HAS**

Have Lunch:Almorzar They _____(have) lunch at 1 p.m. Aquí solo Have
Susan _____(have) lunch at 1 p.m.Aquí HAS, ya que habla de ELLA

*Cuando tenemos CONSONANTE + Y, se quita la Y y se coloca **IES**

Study:Estudiar We _____(study) English. Aquí solo Study
My mother _____(study) English. Aquí Studies por que habla de ella.(mother)

*Cuando tenemos VOCAL + Y, solo se agrega **S**

Play:Jugar Brian _____(play) volleyball. Aquí se pone Plays, ya que Brian es EI

I _____(play) volleyball. Aquí solo Play

*A los demás solo agregamos **S**

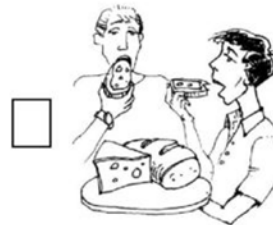
