progress actions at a special time in the past

Peter **was reading** a book yesterday evening.

two actions were happening at the same time (the actions do not influence each other)

Anne **was writing** a letter while Steve **was reading** the New York Times.

together with the Past Progressive/Continuous

The Simple Past interrupted an action which was in progress in the past.

They **were playing** cards, when the telephone **rang**.

1st action → Past Progressive → **were playing**

2nd action → Simple Past → **rang**

repeated actions irritating the speaker (with *always, constantly, forever*)

Andrew **was** always **coming** late.

together with *Simple Past*

While we **were sitting** at the breakfast table, the telephone **rang**.

Signal words

while → **mientras**

Form → **El pasado Continuo se forma:**

to **be (was, were)** + **infinitive** + **-ing**

Examples

Affirmative sentences in the *Past Progressive*

Long forms	Contracted forms
I was playing football.	
You were playing football.	not possible
He was playing football.	

Negative sentences in the *Past Progressive*

Long forms	Contracted forms
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Long forms	Contracted forms
I was not playing football.	I wasn't playing football.
You were not playing football.	You weren't playing football.
He was not playing football.	He wasn't playing football.

4.3. Questions in the *Past Progressive*

Long forms	Contracted forms
Was I playing football?	not possible
Were you playing football?	
Was he playing football?
