TEMA: PAST CONTINUOUS

Referencia Gramatical:

El **pasado continuo** se utiliza para acciones **que** estaban pasando en un momento específico en el **pasado**. Como el presente **continuo**, se forma con el verbo auxiliar "to be" y el verbo+ing.

El "**past continuous**" describe acciones o eventos situados en un tiempo anterior al presente, cuyo comienzo se sitúa en el pasado y que todavía no ha concluido en el momento de hablar. Dicho de otro modo, expresa una acción incompleta o inconclusa del pasado.

Ejemplos oraciones **pasado continuo ingles**. El **pasado continuo** o **pasado** progresivo (past continuous tense) se forma escribiendo el verbo to be que corresponde a cada sujeto en **pasado** simple (was y were) y el verbo principal con la terminación -ing, esta terminación corresponde al gerundio en español.


