Referencia gramatical

En Inglés, los verbos se dividen en: verbos regulares e irregulares. En la clase N° 2 trabajaste verbos regulares y ahora trabajaremos con los irregulares. Subject (sujeto) + simple past verb (verbo en pasado – 2° columna) + complement (complemento)

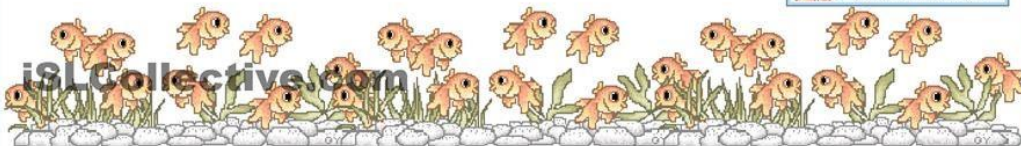

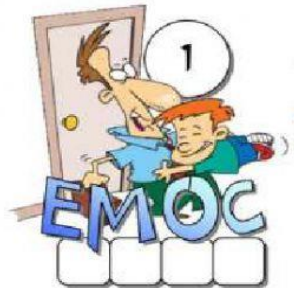
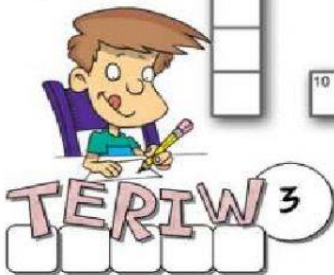
